CLINICAL SUMMARY

Type of Gestation: Singleton

Intrauterine pregnancy in vertex presentation.

Fetal size is appropriate for gestational age by weight.

Fetal growth:

Consistent with normal fetal growth

Fetal motion and organs seen:

A fetal bladder was observed

A fetal stomach was observed

A four chamber cardiac view was observed

Fetal abnormalities observed:

Fetal gender: Male

Placental location: Anterior. Placental maturity -Grade II.

There is no evidence of placenta previa.

Amniotic fluid volume is normal.

The nuchal translucency was greater than 2.5 mm.

There was not funneling of the internal os. Uterus and adnexae: No abnormalities seen
