**CLINICAL SUMMARY**

Type of Gestation: Singleton  
 Intrauterine pregnancy in vertex presentation.  
 Fetal size is appropriate for gestational age by weight.

**Fetal growth:**

Consistent with normal fetal growth

**Fetal motion and organs seen:**

- A fetal bladder was observed
- A fetal stomach was observed
- A four chamber cardiac view was observed

**Fetal abnormalities observed:**

- Fetal gender: Female
- Placental location: Anterior.
- Placental maturity was Grade II.
- There is no evidence of placenta previa.
- Amniotic fluid volume is normal.
- The nuchal translucency was greater than 2.5 mm.
- There was not funnelling of the internal os.
- Uterus and adnexae: No abnormalities seen
