A fetal stomach was observed

A four chamber cardiac view was observed

Fetal abnormalities observed:

Fetal gender: Female

Placental location: Anterior.

Placental maturity was Grade II.

There is no evidence of placenta previa.

Amniotic fluid volume is normal.

The nuchal translucency was greater than 2.5 mm.

There was not funnelling of the internal os. Uterus and adnexae: No abnormalities seen
